

Licenses Committee
May 9, 2011

The Committee on Licenses met on Monday, May 9, 2011.

The meeting was audio taped for the record.

Members present were Alderman L. Charles DiPerri, presiding; Alderman Robert Van Campen and Aldermen Sal Sachetta. Non member present was Alderman Michael Mangan.

City Clerk Michael Matarazzo was also present.

The Committee considered a Petition from Master Printing & Signs for Esmair Rosa to replace permanent awning at Dollar Brazil, 173 Main Street..

The Awning Vendor, Nilson Rigonatti, was also present.

Mr. Rigonatti provided the Committee with a copy of the present and proposed designs. He explained to the Committee that the new sign had already been made at a cost of \$1200 and he was looking for the Board of Alderman's approval on the blue color rather than the required red color listed in the Alderman Rules. Alderman Van Campen noted that the Rules were already in place and that the Board recently required Panda Electric located across the street to change from a black colored awning to the required red color. Alderman DiPerri informed Mr. Rigonatti that the Alderman Rules also prohibits advertising which appears on his proposed awning design. Alderman Sachetta remarked that any approval of the blue colored awning for this site would create issues with Panda Electric who were required to go with a red awning.

The Committee voted: To report back to the Board of Aldermen with an unfavorable recommendation.
