CONSTRUCTION, TESTING AND PLANNING CONTINUES ON THREE PROJECTS

Three major projects continue to move forward this summer, as the construction season in Everett continues. As part of phase two of the Everett Memorial Stadium Project, the visitor's side is being prepped for installation of new, permanent bleachers. E & D Specialty Stands of North Collins, NY is handling the project for the city. The permanent stands will eliminate the need for the city to rent bleachers every season. Meanwhile on the other side of the stadium, City Services crews are busy updating the public bathrooms with new stalls, sinks and a fresh coat of paint. All running projects at the stadium will be complete prior to the first Crimson Tide home game in September.

Adding to the improvement schedule, NESRA Engineering, the design firm working on the Glendale Park project, will be taking a series of soil samples at Glendale Park. As preliminary design nears completion these test samples will determine the appropriate conditions for new lighting at the park. The Mayor is hoping for completed design documents in the coming weeks in order to present the design to city officials and neighbors. With a design in place, the Community Development office will again submit for PARC grant funding from the State. The soil testing will not interrupt any ongoing activities at the park.

The Administration was also busy looking for options for the Beacham Street area. The City retained WorldTech Engineering, of Woburn, a municipal planning, engineering, and project management firm to focus solely on improvements to Beacham Street, the City's main industrial sector. Currently the City and consultants from WorldTech, are working on preliminary planning and design elements, as well as aggressively seeking funding sources to offset costs of the project. The Mayor is working to get design elements in place to qualify for both Federal and State grant funds.
