

The Committee on Community & Business Development met on Monday, February 22, 2021 at 6:30pm remotely through the Zoom web application.

Members present remotely were Councilor Rosa Diflorio, presiding, Councilors Michael Marchese, John Hanlon and Gerly Adrien.

The Committee considered an Order offered by Councilor Wayne Matewsky, as President: That the Everett City Council considers a new mechanical auto repair license for Main Street Auto at 394 Main Street. .

Legislative Aide Michael Mangan and Petitioner Estephanos Khalil were also present remotely through the zoom application.

The Committee was informed that it was in receipt of Department approvals for the location from the Building Department, Fire Prevention and Treasurer/Collectors Office. Mr. Mangan informed the Committee that the former license for premise showed the hours of operation from 7am to 8:30pm Monday thru Saturday. Mr. Khalil informed the Committee that he would be pumping gas from 6am to 10pm but would only be doing repair work from 7am to 6pm Monday thru Saturday. Councilor Hanlon noted that he had visited the business and talked to the new Owner and found the premises to be well kept and the staff very knowledgeable. Councilor Marchese welcomed Mr. Khalil and wished him well. The Committee recommended amending the hours of operation for mechanical repair work from 7am to 6pm Monday thru Friday.

The Committee voted: To report back to the City Council with a recommendation for favorable action with the amended hours of operation of 7am to 6pm Monday thru Saturday.
